2011 Grass Cutting Schedule

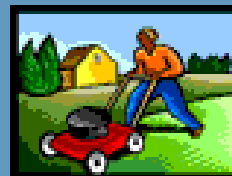
This year we will need the grass cut at least 9 times. The approximate dates are;
