The Rib Mountain Bowmen was founded in 1953, making this one of the oldest archery clubs in northern Wisconsin. Over the years the club has undergone several face lifts and expansion projects, with a new clubhouse being built in 1987. In 2008 RMB purchased an additional 20 acres giving use a total of 40 acres of lush wooded property.

Today we offer a 16 station, 20 yard indoor range we also have a 10-70 yard outdoor field tip range and a 20-50 yard outdoor broadhead range, as well as an excellent 28 station walking broadhead course in the woods. This course is used for both 3D and Silhouette shooting.

Rib Mountain Bowmen is a membership based archery club. We are a non-profit private club and have 4 different types of memberships.

1. **Working membership** - \$45.00 per year plus 10 hours of work hours.
2. **Non-working membership** - \$145.00 per year with no work hour requirement.
3. **Life Member** - \$1000.00 one time fee with no work requirement. A key fee of \$15.00 is still required.
4. **Honorary Membership** - \$25.00 per year. No key, no work hour obligations,

1. Working membership;

This membership is a family membership that includes anyone in your immediate family up to and including age 17.

- A working membership costs \$45.00 per year.
- You receive one key for the club house allowing you to shoot archery 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and 365 days per year. There are a few days each year that are set aside for events and several nights per week for leagues during the winter months. See the club schedule for reserved dates. Barring that, the range can be used anytime.
- One RMB membership hat with an option to purchase more for \$10.00 each.
- All members receive a copy of our news letter called "The Bowbunk" via e-mail. If you would like a hard copy, one is available in the club house for you to pick up on your next visit.
- You are required to help out by working events or maintenance at the club for a minimum of 10 hours during the course of the year. If you can work more hours than the minimum, we appreciate that.... These work hours can be as hard as you want to make them or as easy too. Work hours are explained in the work hour document with a schedule. There is a \$10.00 per hour charge for any hours less than the 10 required.

2. Non-Working membership;

This membership is a family membership that includes anyone in your immediate family up to and including age 17.

- A Non-working membership costs \$145.00 per year.
- You receive one key for the club house allowing you to shoot archery 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and 365 days per year. There are a few days each year that are set aside for events and several nights per week for leagues during the winter months. See the club schedule for reserved dates. Barring that, the range can be used anytime.
- One RMB membership hat with an option to purchase more for \$10.00 each.
- All members receive a copy of our news letter called “The Bowbunk” via e-mail. If you would like a hard copy one is available in the club house for you to pick up on your next visit.
- There is no work hour requirement with this membership. That does not mean we would turn you down if you chose to help out in some way.

3. Life member;

This membership is a family membership that includes anyone in your immediate family up to and including age 17.

- A Life Membership costs \$1000.00 and is a one-time fee, plus a key fee per year. Most years this is around \$15.00
- You receive one key for the club house allowing you to shoot archery 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and 365 days per year. There are a few days each year that are set aside for events and several nights per week for leagues during the winter months. Barring that the range can be used anytime.
- One RMB membership hat with an option to purchase more for \$10.00 each.
- All Life Members receive a copy of our news letter called “The Bowbunk” via e-mail. If you would like a hard copy, one is available in the club house for you to pick up on your next visit.
- There is no work hour requirement with this membership. That does not mean we would turn you down if you chose to help out in some way.

4. Honorary Membership;

This membership is an individual membership. This membership is intended for a person that does not live near RMB and still would like to help support RMB financially.

An Honorary Membership costs \$25.00 per year.

- One RMB membership hat with an option to purchase more for \$10.00 each.
- All honorary members will receive a copy of our news letter called “The Bowbunk” via e-mail only.
- There is no club benefit to this membership other than the above mentioned.
